Permanent Stormwater System Maintenance and Responsibility Agreement

Under the South Carolina Stormwater Management and Sediment Reduction Act of 1991 (48-14-10, et. seq.), Regulation 72-308 requires the Landowner, its successors and assigns, including any homeowners association, shall adequately maintain the stormwater management/Best Management Practices (BMP) facilities. This includes all pipes and channels built to convey stormwater to the facility, as well as all structures, improvements, and vegetation provided to control the quantity and quality of the stormwater. Adequate maintenance is herein defined as good working condition so that these facilities are performing their design functions.

The Department of Health and Control (DHEC) and/or Pickens County Office of Stormwater Management recommends that The Landowner, its successors and assigns, shall inspect the stormwater management/BMP facility regularly. The purpose of the inspection is to assure safe and proper functioning of the facilities. The inspection shall cover the entire facilities, berms, outlet structure, pond areas, access roads, etc.

The Landowner, its successors and assigns, hereby grant permission to the DHEC and/or Pickens County its authorized agents and employees, to enter upon the Property and to inspect the stormwater management/BMP facilities whenever DHEC and/or Pickens County deems necessary. The purpose of inspection is to follow-up on reported deficiencies and/or to respond to citizen complaints. DHEC/Pickens County shall provide the Landowner, its successors and assigns, copies of the inspection findings and a directive to commence with the repairs if necessary.

The Landowner, its successors and assigns, will perform the work necessary to keep these facilities in good working order as appropriate. In the event a maintenance schedule for the stormwater management/BMP facilities (including sediment removal) is outlined on the approved plans, the schedule will be followed.

This Agreement imposes no liability of any kind whatsoever on DHEC/Pickens County and the Landowner agrees to hold DHEC/Pickens County harmless from any liability in the event the stormwater management/BMP facilities fail to operate properly.
